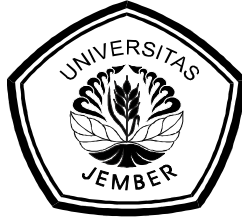

## ABSTRACT

Habit is a part of human behavior. Examples of habits are the routine activities such as washing, walking, dressing, etc. The bad habit deals with the habit that is unacceptable or incorrect especially according to social values. It may be unpleasant or even harmful for the one who does it. Besides, the habit may also give bad influences toward other people's life.

This thesis analyzes the effects of Vivian Nichols' bad habits toward Sir Alec Nichols' life as her husband in *Bloodline*. It is the novel created by an American writer, Sidney Sheldon. The bad habits of Vivian Nichols and how they affect her husband's life are the problems that will be discussed in this thesis.
