Case Presentation

- 5 years old female child
- Patient came with abdominal pain → referred to our hospital because of suspected acute appendicitis
- Leukocyte 13.000, Neutrophil 56%
- The patient had a history of delayed passage of meconium, chronic constipation, and routine use of laxative

- We suspected Hirschsprung Disease.
- An enema with NaCl 0,9% + Glycerin was given for three days
- Contrast enema was done on day 4

- Patient was discharged after routine defecation on day 5
- At one month follow up → patient came with history of not passing stool for the past 4 days

Questions

- What is the diagnosis and differential diagnosis?
- Do we need to perform a rectal biopsy?
- What is better: an enema or manual fecal disimpaction under general anesthesia?
- If enemas fail, can we do a disimpaction under anesthesia?
