ABSTRACT

The Impact of Racial Atmosphere toward Lily's Attitude in Black Community in Sue Monk Kidd's *The Secret Life of Bees*

The belief that one race is superior than the other races, has been accused since the first men are created by God. Human firstly socializes only with similar physical appearances. This gathering which is known later as races happens, in each part of our world, including America. America which is used to be popular as a new world has been attracting many races to taste the beauty of this Island. It is why American is called as an Island that is usually known or called "melting pot". Unfortunately, the Black race, one of races that came to America, did not arrive as citizen but as the slaves of white American. Afterwards, even the slavery was abolished in two hundred years ago in fact the Blacks are still threatened racist by American society. Sue Monk Kidd as the white woman author tries to raise the problem of racism in America and inspires her to write The Secret Life of Bees.
