A Farewell to Arms is one of the great works of Ernest Hemingway. He is one of the greatest authors in the twentieth century. In this novel, Hemingway stresses on the character of Frederic Henry. He is the main character in the novel. Frederic is a young American who enlists himself in the Italian army as the ambulance driver during the First World War. Moreover, the First World War is time full of confusion, desperation, and loneliness. It gives bad influences to people's life, mentally and psychologically. Frederic must face the traumatic effects of the war.
