A Series of Unfortunate Events is children literature. Children literature ussually tells about joyful adventure, fantasies, and amusing story. It can expand their knowledge and even fills them with fantasies. It can also shape children's way of thinking. However, A Series of Unfortunate Events is not a story about joys, amusing fantasies, exciting danger of adventures, nor even a happy ending story.
