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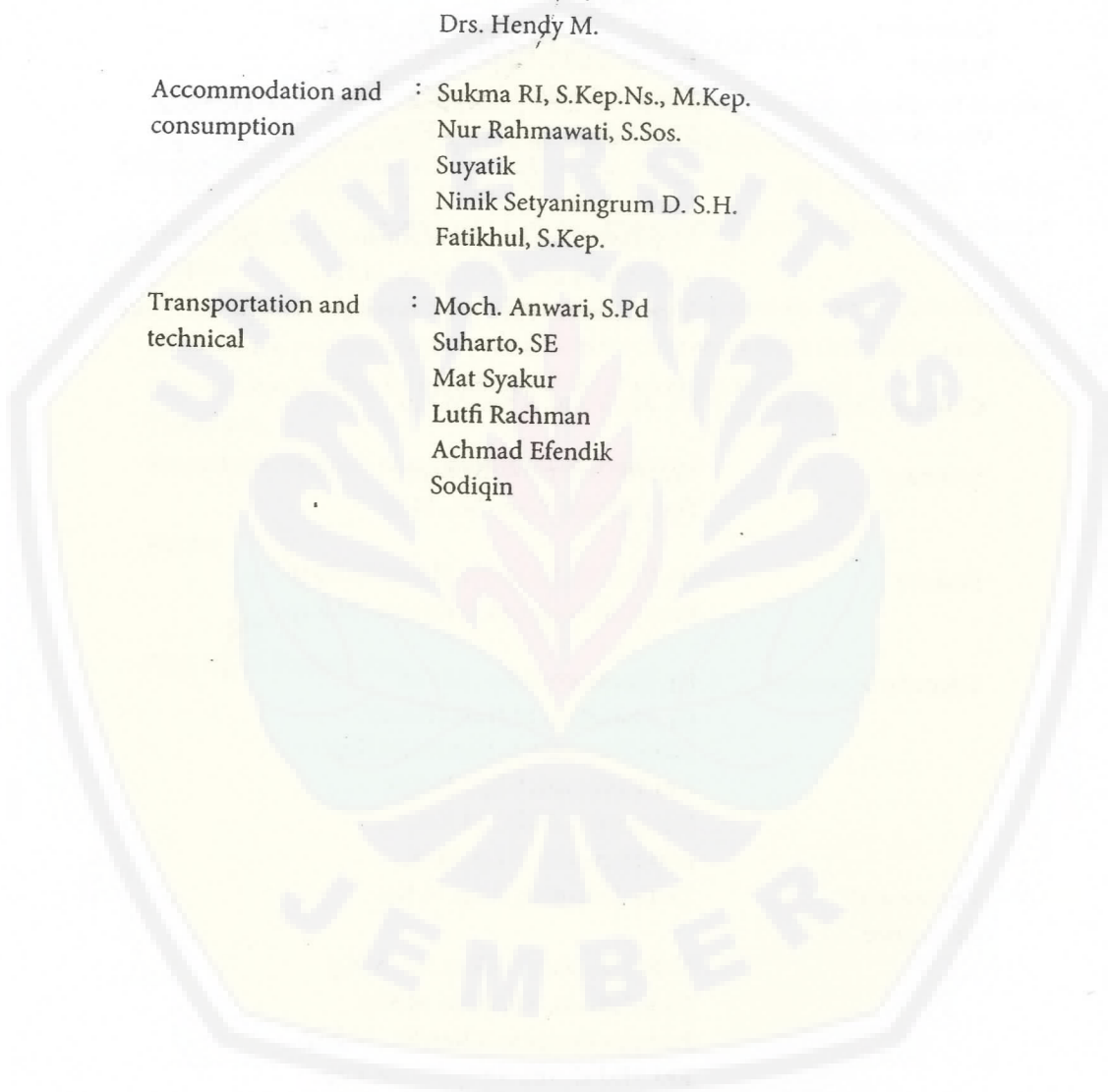

SELF EXERCISE WITH GYM'S LEPROSY FOR REDUCING OF DISABILTY CLIENT LEPROSY DEGREE AT JEMBER SUB DISTRICT, EAST JAVA, INDONESIA

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Leprosy in community is one's of *Neglected Tropical Diseases* (NTDs) that needed caring for improving their quality of life. One's of caring intervention is self exercise with eyes, hands and foots to reduce the degree of disability. These research want to identification that influences of self exercise with their eyes, hands, and foots for reduce the degree of disability cliet's leprosy. The design that used was quasy experimental study with cross sectional approach. Samples are 30 client's leprosy with simple random sampling method in Jelbuk, Ajung and Tempurejo Community Health Center of Jember. Research study at February to April 2013. The results showed that have differences about degree of disability client'leprosy before and after intervention self exercise with gym leprosy, so there was influences about self exercise with gym's leprosy with degree of disability of client's leprosy (p value 0,001). Client's leprosy needed more exercise with caring self care their eyes, hand, and foots to prevent disability progresevily.
