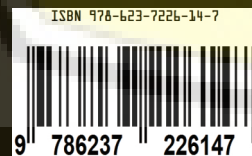

CRITICAL LISTENING

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Critical listening is one of the compulsory subjects that mainly focuses on training the students to be more critical on the information they hear or watch so that they are able to make appropriate judgement or conclusion. This subject will teach students to differentiate facts and opinion, verify information whether it is relevant or not to support their analysis and evaluation. However, these skills of course are not easily learned without proper material and practice. This book provides interesting topics and tasks that can be used to foster students' critical listening skill.

Each chapter offers at least two podcasts or videos which are taken from the internet. The combination of podcast and videos as the materials could facilitate students with different learning styles. There are pictures in every chapter that can be used to stimulate students' prior knowledge. The book also provides some leading questions that can be used by the teacher for pre-listening activity.

The task in every chapter is designed to drill the students to be critical listeners. 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GLOSSARY

Ambivert	:	a person whose personality has a balance of extrovert and introvert features
Addicted	:	Factors such as peer pressure, physical and sexual abuse, early exposure to drugs, stress, and parental guidance can greatly affect a person's likelihood of drug use and addiction. Development. Genetic and environmental factors interact with critical developmental stages in a person's life to affect addiction risk.
Burden	:	a load, typically a heavy one.
Blossom	:	a flower or a mass of flowers, especially on a tree or bush.
Brain training	:	a program of regular mental activities purported to maintain or improve one's cognitive abilities.
Copyright	:	the exclusive legal right, given to an originator or an assignee to print, publish, perform, film, or record literary, artistic, or musical material, and to authorize others to do the same.
Celebration	:	the action of marking one's pleasure at an important event or occasion by engaging in enjoyable, typically social, activity.
Custom	:	the official department that administers and collects the duties levied by a government on imported goods.
Cheating	:	act dishonestly or unfairly in order to gain an advantage, especially in a game or examination.

Grading system	:	Grading in education is the process of applying standardized measurements of varying levels of achievement in a course. The GPA is calculated by taking the number of grade points a student earned in a given period of time of middle school through high school.
Invasive weeds	:	A weed is any plant that requires some form of action to reduce its effect on the economy, the environment, human health and amenity. Weeds are also known as invasive plants. A weed can be an exotic species or a native species that colonies and persists in an ecosystem in which it did not previously exist.
Implication	:	the conclusion that can be drawn from something although it is not explicitly stated.
Introvert	:	a shy, reticent person.
Impact	:	the action of one object coming forcibly

		into contact with another.
Infringement	:	the action of breaking the terms of a law, agreement, etc.; violation.
Insight	:	The understanding of a specific cause and effect within a specific context. The term insight can have several related meanings: a piece of information. the act or result of understanding the inner nature of things or of seeing intuitively (called noesis in Greek)
Learning atmosphere	:	When you create a positive classroom atmosphere, students learn better. Every student must feel safe and important in the class in order for maximum learning to take place. A positive classroom environment does not just happen; the teacher creates it. Lead your students by example
Memory	:	the faculty of the brain by which information is encoded, stored, and retrieved when needed. Memory is vital to experiences, it is the retention of information over time for the purpose of influencing future action.
Online friends	:	to describe people they only know through social media (facebook, twitter, instagram etc), acquaintances that they have just started getting to know, or folks they have a friendship with online only.
Thanksgiving	:	a national holiday celebrated on various dates in Canada, the United States, some of the Caribbean islands, and Liberia. It began as a day of giving thanks and sacrifice for the blessing of the harvest and of the preceding year.
Unbiased	:	showing no prejudice for or against something; impartial.

Pleasant	:	giving a sense of happy satisfaction or enjoyment.
Personality	:	Personality refers to individual differences in characteristic patterns of thinking, feeling and behaving. The study of personality focuses on two broad areas: One is understanding individual differences in particular personality characteristics, such as sociability or irritability.
Preferable	:	more desirable or suitable.
Plagiarism	:	Using someone else's text without attribution, whether you meant to do it or not. Unintentional plagiarism of even a sentence or two can have serious consequences. For students, plagiarism often means a failing grade, academic probation, or worse.
